Qualifying: Paul Granger (44.50), Patrick Pearce, Adam Murphy Heat winners: Pearce, Granger Final 1: Granger lost the first heat when knocked off by Murphy, who was excluded, then Granger was sent to the back again when Pearce's throttle cable broke at the start. He stormed through to second with Michael Kent nearly three seconds ahead. Tamsin Germain was a clear third.

Final 2: Dropping to third at the start was only a temporary setback for Granger, before he sliced under Kent at turn one. Murphy caught out Lassu at turn two, then she slid to sixth, whilst Pearce recovered to fifth from the back.
